WHY HAVE A QUIZMASTER?

- The average human attention span in the year 2000 was 12 seconds.
- Since then our attention spans have been declining.
- Now in 2022 the average human attention span is only 8 seconds.

Which is less than this goldfish who has an average attention span of nine seconds.



WHY HAVE A QUIZMASTER?

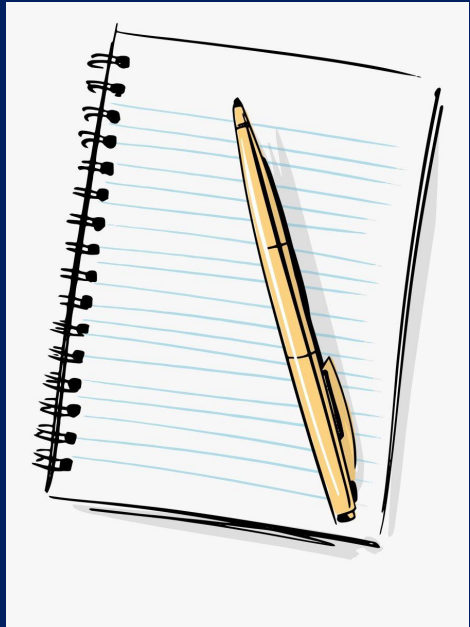
- Too many distractions in modern life.
- Quizmaster provides an incentive to pay attention.
- You can show you've been listening.



WHAT DOES A QUIZMASTER DO?

- Listen carefully during the meeting.
- Create six or more questions based on the content of the meeting.
- They run a question and answer session at the end of the meeting.

HOW TO WRITE QUESTIONS



- Questions not too easy or hard.
- What was said, done or learned during the meeting.
- Choose interesting facts.

EXAMPLE QUESTIONS

- What was Meesha's favorite book?
- During Andy's speech, what was his wife's name?
- What award did Cassie win?

WHAT TO AVOID

Hard Questions

What was the first word of the second sentence in Max's speech?

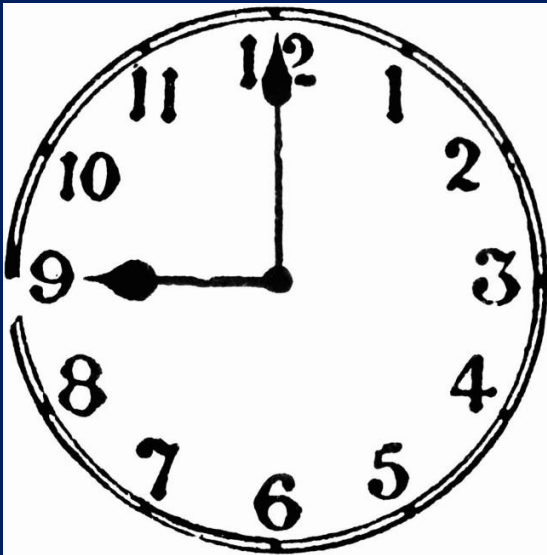
Judgmental Questions

How did John fail as a father?

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

- One minute or less for question and answer session.
- Invite the participants to unmute their microphones.
- Ask a question and wait for the answer. If no response is given, provide the answer.
- Congratulate those who get the **CORRECT** answer.

KEEP TIME IN MIND



If the meeting has gone longer than expected there may only be time for two or three questions. If time allows you can ask additional questions. Then turn the meeting back to the Toastmaster.
